## Answers and Explanation

1. Answer: 20, Explanation: To find the sum, add 12 and 8 together:  $12 + 8 = 20$ .
2. Answer: 9, Explanation: Start with 15 candies and subtract the 6 you give away:  $15 - 6 = 9$ .
3. Answer: 15, Explanation: The pattern increases by 3 each time. Starting from 12, add 3:  $12 + 3 = 15$ .
4. Answer: 12, Explanation: Each cat has 4 legs. For three cats, multiply 4 by 3:  $4 \times 3 = 12$ .
5. Answer: Pentagon, Explanation: A pentagon is a shape with exactly 5 sides.
6. Answer: 12, Explanation: Multiply the number of boxes (4) by the number of toys per box (3):  $4 \times 3 = 12$ .
7. Answer: 15, Explanation: Subtract 5 from 20:  $20 - 5 = 15$ .
8. Answer: 10, Explanation: Each hand has 5 fingers. For two hands, add 5 + 5:  $5 + 5 = 10$ .
9. Answer: 50, Explanation: The sequence increases by 10 each time. From 40, add 10:  $40 + 10 = 50$ .
10. Answer: 9, Explanation: Add the number of red balloons (5) and blue balloons (4):  $5 + 4 = 9$ .
11. Answer: 12; Explanation: Multiply 3 by 4:  $3 \times 4 = 12$ .
12. Answer: 32, Explanation: Compare the two numbers: 25 is less than 32, so 32 is larger.
13. Answer: 12, Explanation: A year has exactly 12 months.
14. Answer: 15, Explanation: Add the additional 5 stickers to your original 10:  $10 + 5 = 15$ .
15. Answer: Sphere, Explanation: A soccer ball is a round, three-dimensional object, which is called a sphere.
